Why study Chinese?

- One fifth of the world's population speaks Chinese.
- The Chinese economy has been growing rapidly. More and more Americans are going to China or inter-acting with China in their business, work or study.
- In the San Juan Unified School District, Chinese is only offered at Churchill Middle School and Mira Loma High School.

Class Description:

Beginning Chinese as a Second Language (Class A): for students from families that do not speak Mandarin at home and have never studied Chinese formally or informally. Students will learn to speak, understand and read up to 188 Chinese simplified characters/Pinyin equivalents and to write up to 46 such characters/Pinyin equivalent: students will also learn to make and read simple social conversation such as greeting and farewell, asking name, asking age, asking about family, etc. Textbook used is Chinese Made Easy for Kids, Level 1 (with CD) plus supplementary learning material provided by the teacher.

Beginning Chinese (Class B): for students from families that speak Mandarin at home or who have previously studied spoken Mandarin but who have not learned to read and write Chinese in a formal classroom setting. Students will learn to speak, understand, read, and write a few hundred Chinese simplified characters (words)/Pinyin equivalents. phrases and sentences. Focus will be on reading and writing. Textbook used is Chinese Made Easy, Level 1 (with CD) plus supplementary learning material provided by the teacher.

Material fee:	\$23 (Class A) or \$30 (Class B) (includes textbook w/ CD and supplemental materials)
